Legal Information:

Tennessee Unemployment Benefits - Claimant Services

Unemployment Insurance (UI) is a benefit program funded by Tennessee employers for workers who have lost their job when it is not their fault. This resource from the state of Tennessee can provide more information on how to apply for unemployment benefits along with additional information.

Unemployment Appeals

If you applied for unemployment benefits and were denied, you have the right to file an appeal. Find more information on how to appeal an agency decision from the Tennessee Department of Labor and Workforce Development in the above link.

TN Free Legal Answers

If you are in Tennessee, the website, Free Legal Answers, allows you to ask a lawyer for help with a legal issue at no cost. It is fast and easy, and all you need is a computer. This is a FREE service for people who cannot afford a lawyer.

How it works:

- You will answer a few questions to see if you qualify for their service. If you qualify, you will have the option to create an account.
- If you are eligible, you can ask their volunteer attorneys a non-criminal legal question.
- Once your question receives a response, you will get an email. You will need to sign into the website to read your response and ask any additional questions.
