National Resources

Stateside Legal

Stateside Legal is a national resource that can provide legal help for military members, veterans, and their families.

Lawyers Serving Warriors

Lawyers Serving Warriors is a program through the National Veterans Legal Services Programs. They offer free legal help to veterans with disability across all eras.

Directory of the National Organization of Veterans' Advocates

Veteran Benefits Information

StatesideLegal VA Benefits Quick Screening Guide

This benefit screener asks questions to help you find out what veterans benefits you might qualify for as a veteran or surviving spouse of a veteran. These benefits include: disability, pension or DIC (Dependency and Indemnity Compensation).

Federal Benefits for Veterans, Dependents and Survivors Manual - 2018 Online Edition

This guide from the U.S Department of Veterans Affairs outlines benefits for veterans including: health care benefits, non-health care benefits, and burial and memorial benefits.

Arrested? What Happens to Your Benefits if You Go to Jail or Prison?

If you are arrested, use this resource from the Bazelon Center for Mental Health Law to find out what happens to your Social Security and health care benefits while you are in jail.

Statewide Resources

Tennessee Department of Veterans Affairs

Middle Tennessee

Supportive Services for Veteran Families

Under the SSVF Program, Legal Services provides assistance to case managers, specialists, and Veterans and their families. If you are a Veteran dealing with legal issues that interfere with your ability to obtain and sustain permanent housing, you may qualify. This program serves 20 middle Tennessee counties.

Forms

Standard Court Forms for all of Tennessee

This resource contains standard court forms that are approved for all counties of Tennessee. If you need help filing one of these forms, you can ask a lawyer in your area.

Legal Advice:

TN Free Legal Answers

If you are in Tennessee, the website, Free Legal Answers, allows you to ask a lawyer for help with a legal issue at no cost. It is fast and easy, and all you need is a computer. This is a FREE service for people who cannot afford a lawyer.

How it works:

- You will answer a few questions to see if you qualify for their service. If you qualify, you will have the option to create an account.
- If you are eligible, you can ask their volunteer attorneys a non-criminal legal question.
- Once your question receives a response, you will get an email. You will need to sign into the website to read your response and ask any additional questions.
