Services of the Clay County Public Library will be provided without regard to race, gender, economic status, or disability.

The library has a broad selection of legal self-help, reference and legal forms books. If needed, the library staff is available to help locate these materials and other online resources.

There are nine (9) internet accessible computers available for the public to use. There is no fee for the use of the computer, but there is a \$.20 per page fee for printing.

A copy machine is available for public use, with a \$.20 per page fee for copies.

A fax machine is available. Each fax is \$1.00 to send.
